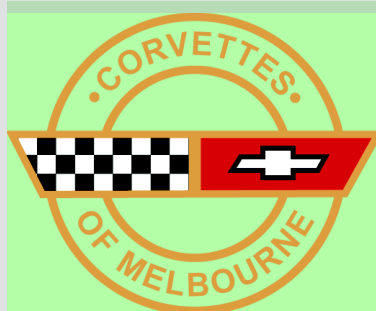

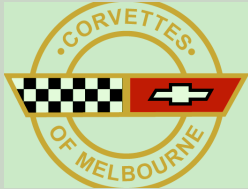

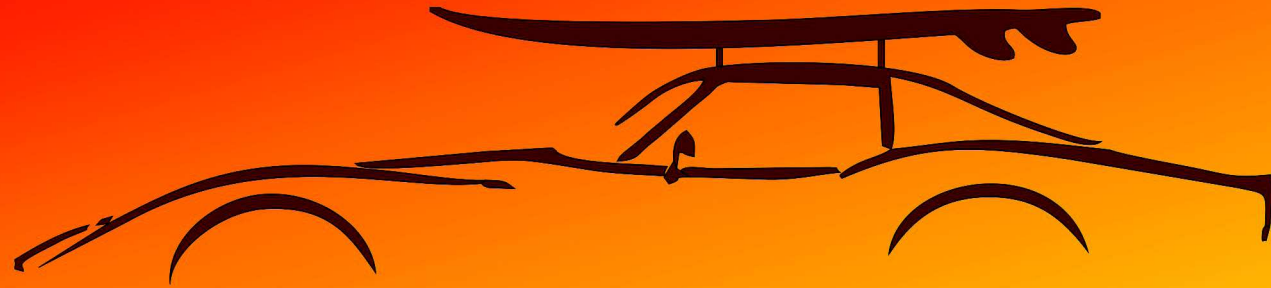

28th Historic Sandown





Despite the ordinary weather, we had five C3 Corvettes on display at Sandown Park for the 28th Historic race meeting. We were fortunate enough to be able to display the cars in front of the main grandstand along with a mix of Mustangs, Torana's and even a DeTomaso Pantera.

The event was run over three days with over 40 events and over 500 historic race and display cars. The cold weather meant it was a good excuse to walk around the pits and see the vast array of cars and the impressive trailers and mechanical workshops required to support these race cars. It certainly takes owning a classic car to a whole new level. At the affordable end of the spectrum one of the members from the Holden HQ racing Vic team spent some time with us promoting their club. You can buy a HQ Holden Racing Car (1971-1974) for between \$9,000 - \$12000.00 and they provided a detailed brochure on all the on costs required to race the vehicle covering off tyres, brakes, fuel, spare parts and race entry fees. The beauty of these vehicles is that they are not modified and run on a standard 6 cylinder engine and a three speed manual to ensure all competitors compete on equal terms.



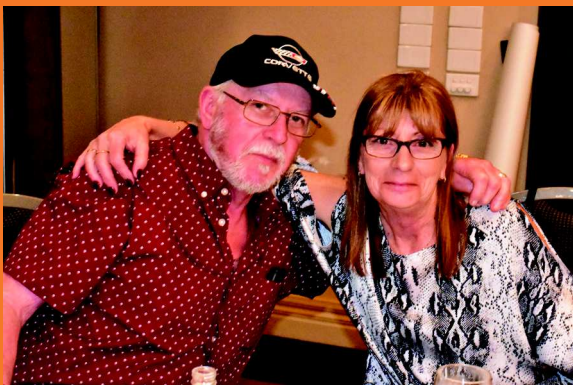
Obviously we were there to see the Corvettes on track and there was a good range of C2's and C3's on display. We had a fair wait to see the Corvette's on the track due to an accident in one of the earlier qualifying races (refer picture) which resulted in the track being closed for about an hour and half which coincidentally was about the same it took to queue for coffee given the bitterly cold wind !

Once the racing got going again the Corvettes looked fantastic on the track and certainly looked to be more than holding their own against the other Mustangs, Porches and Alpha Romeo's in this category. The Red C2 (Number 44) was one of the quickest on the track and certainly had the best sound flying down the straight.

Thanks to the organising committee for arranging this event and it is one to keep on the calendar for next year.

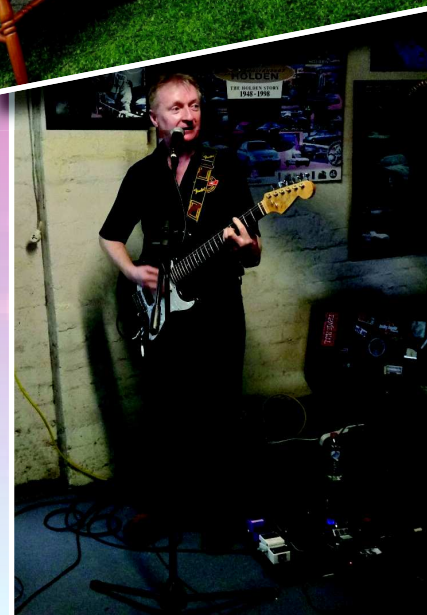
TOY BOX

'Thank you' to George Arhontogeorge for organising this run, great job !

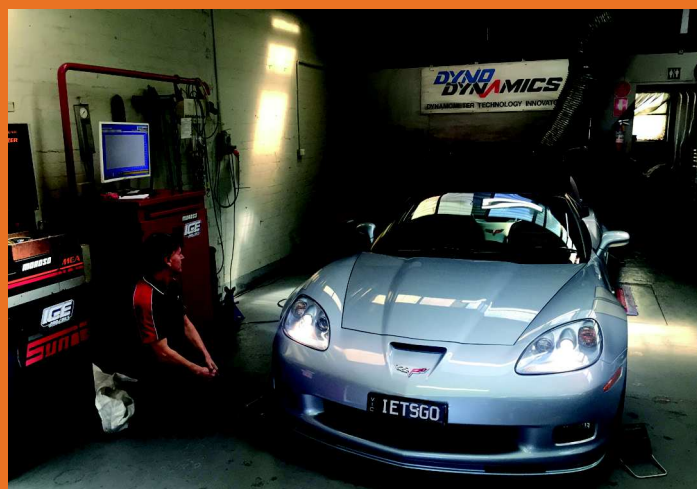


Dyno Day #2

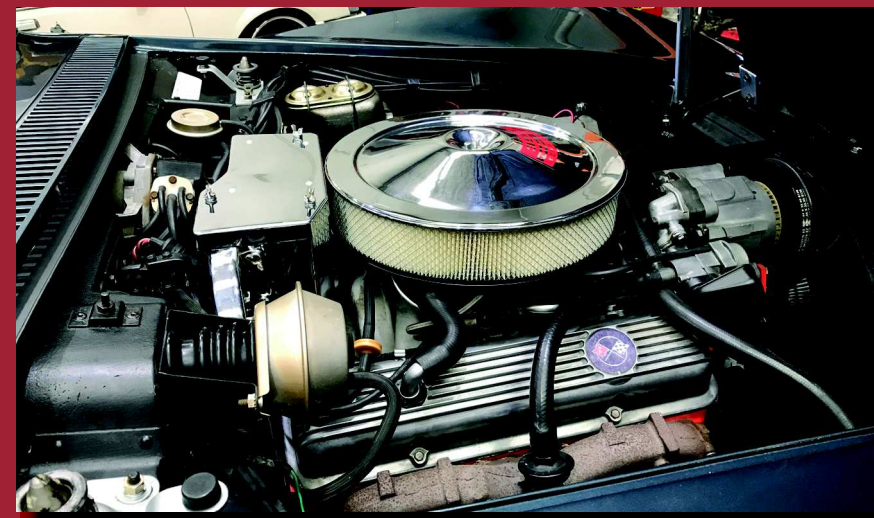

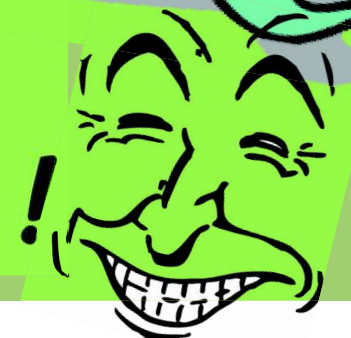

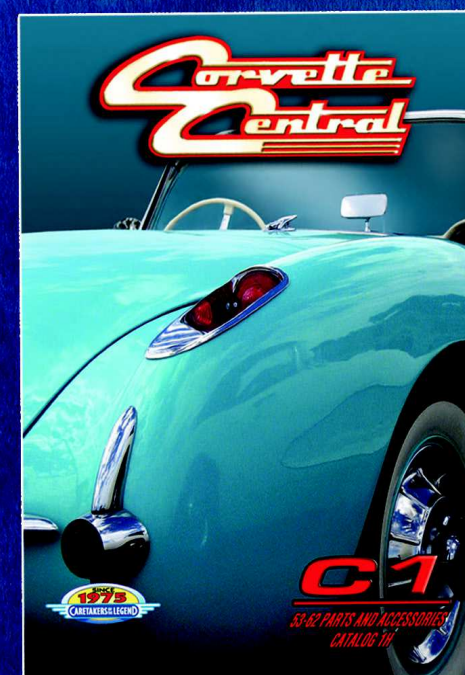
