Yes it's time again for the club AGM! As usual all positions up for grabs and if you can spare a small amount of time per week to support the club and are interested, please come along and put your hand up, or at least to vote to determine the future direction of our club. Below you will find a brief summary of each role (more detail available from current or past position holders):

President: The President is the leader of the club and is there to ensure the club is run efficiently administratively, financially and socially to support the enjoyment of our vehicles. The club president is responsible for running club meetings and committee meetings, guiding committee members, delegating tasks as necessary. and maintaining regular open communication as the face of the club.

Vice President: The role of the Vice President can be summarized in one word - service The Vice President serves the President, other club officers, committees and the general membership. He or she is also expected to learn the duties of the President in order to fill in or take over as necessary.

Secretary & Public Officer: A good secretary is essential to the proper functioning of any club. The secretary is responsible for taking minutes, setting agenda, keeping records and maintaining all important files for the club.

Treasurer: The Treasurer controls the club's money, both its collection and disbursement. He or she collects member dues, maintains accurate financial records and reports these at meetings.

Membership Officer: The membership officer should be a welcoming face for all visitors and new members and a point of contact to guide them into the club and to meet fellow members. This involves arranging name tags and informing relevant committee members of guests and new members and is also responsible for driving membership renewals and chasing expired members.

Events Coordinator: This role organises a range of events for members and encouraging attendance. Events can be organised by members and you oversee and guide them, or they can be organised by you, but it is important to ensure a good calendar of events for the year and they are publicised. Additionally, you or a delegate you assign, needs to ensure the days are planned and managed.

Gazette Editor: The Gazette Editor is responsible for keeping the membership informed about important activities, past activities and news within the club. This involves sourcing the articles/content, creating a monthly newsletter and sending it to the club printer for printing.

Webmaster: A role which involves keeping the website up to date with event details for members to be able to check. It is also the key marketing face to the public, so it is important to ensure the website is up to date and contains content to draw in new potential members.

Archivist: Manage the historical stock of assets for the club. Ensure these are advertised to club members and made available when requested. Manage and track borrowed assets and ensure that they are returned in an appropriate manner and the same condition - ie books, etc.

Merchandise Manager: Manage the club's merchandise by promoting and selling it and managing stock quantities and when required, working with the committee and members to purchase more stock or create new merchandise.






C3 Headlight Relays

C3 headlight brightness can be improved by installing relays to eliminate the voltage drop in wiring and the headlight switch.

This approach from "Richard454" on the forum is neat in that it doesn't require any modification of the existing harness and plugs into one of the headlight sockets. It would also allow you to use higher power halogen globes.



Another approach is to buy a complete kit from one of the vendors like this one from CorvetteMods.

FIRST 2022 CORVETTE ALLOCATION



The new mid-engine Corvette C8 has gone world-wide, bringing American-style supercar performance to a number of international markets, including Australia. Indeed, the popularity of America's sports car is running high, as evidenced by the fact that the first 2022 Corvette Stingray allocation has already sold out in Australia.

Per a recent report from the Australian publication CarAdvice, all 250 units of the 2022 Corvette slated for delivery to Australia are already spoken for, even before the first unit has arrived on Australian shores. According to CarAdvice, some buyers have agreed to delivery fees in excess of AU\$20,000 (about \$14,774 at current exchange rates) in order to secure their new 2022 Corvette Stingray, with drive-away prices sometimes exceeding \$200,000 (\$147,744).

The latest C8 Chevy Corvette will be sold in right-hand drive from the factory, a first for the Corvette nameplate. Australian buyers will get their new ride through General Motors Specialty Vehicles (GMSV), the new subsidiary for the Australian market, which arrived as a replacement for Holden last year.

ALREADY SOLD OUT IN AUSTRALIA







GM confirmed that the first allocation of 2022 Corvette models for Australia was indeed already sold out, but indicated that further units would allocated for the 2022 model year, followed by allocation for the 2023 model year as well. Dealers are expected to receive between three and five vehicles, with very little choice in terms of options or colors.

The Aussie-spec 2022 Corvette trims include the 2LT, priced at AU\$144,990 (\$107,107 at current exchange rates) plus on-road costs, the 3LT, priced at AU\$160,500 (\$118,565 at current exchange rates) plus on-road costs, and the range-topping Carbon

Edition, priced at \$189,990 (\$140,349 at current exchange rates) before on-road costs. The 2LT and 3LT will also be available in a convertible body style, as well.

For now, there's no official word if GM will offer the go-faster C8 Chevy Corvette Z06 in Australian market. That said, the automaker recently filed to trademark "Z06" in Australia and New Zealand, as GM Authority covered.
