#### Sunday 26 March 2023





There is a 200 seat bistro for dinner on the Sat night.



It will take around 50 mins from our meeting spot to get to the venue.







### **AUSTRALIAN C8 AUCTIONED AT LLOYDS**

Anyone interested in the Corvette C8 knows the car is being built in right-hand-drive (RHD) configuration for countries including Australia, but that the number of cars being made available in Australia is limited, falling well below customer demand.

Although GM, trading in Australia as GM Specialty Vehicles (GMSV), had promised an initial shipment of some 240 cars to its dealers, followed by another shipment in its first year, the actual number of cars sold in Australia in the first 5 months has numbered only 93. If this import rate remains unchanged, the expected Australian deliveries for this year will be about 223 cars. It would seem safe to assume this number falls at least 100 cars short of GMSV's expectation.

This has caused a huge pent-up demand in Australia for the C8. This demand has prompted the GMSV dealers to profiteer on their sales by charging exorbitant dealer delivery fees. It is not unusual for a dealer to ask for \$20,000 to prepare a C8 for delivery – a task that is generally acknowledged to be worth about \$500 - \$700. Because dealers must base their sale price on the RRP of the car, the only way to increase their profit is to add a hefty sum to the dealer delivery fee. GMSV, nor any other vehicle wholesaler, has any power to control the dealer's delivery fee.

The next step in the price escalation was initiated by those customers who were high on the delivery list quickly placing their C8s on the open market, adding almost \$100,000 to their buying price and flipping their cars to willing buyers at that price. C8s have appeared on sites such as carsales.com at a price of \$300,000 and more. The cars have subsequently disappeared from the sites with rumours circulating among the Corvette community as to their final selling price.

So it was interesting to see a C8 recently appear at an Australian auction so we could all see what someone would actually pay to jump the C8 queue. The auction at Lloyds Auctioneers was given a nice shot in the arm by the GMSV announcement that the future MY2023 Corvette C8s would undergo a price rise of \$15,000. I have intimate knowledge of a well optioned 3LT Coupe which has been delayed to now be delivered as a MY2023, the price of which has as a result been raised to around \$230,000.

The C8 being auctioned was a new, unregistered 3LT Coupe with just 14 delivery kms on the clock. The car was painted in Hypersonic Grey with a two-tone Natural (saddle) and Jet Black leather interior. There are a few additional options visible on the car such as the black wheels and badges, plus red brake calipers, which push the price up by quite a few thousand dollars. The bidding was soon at \$235,000, easing up a little every few days as the deadline approached on Saturday, 8th June. When the clock ran down, the bidding had reached \$255,000, well over the price you would expect to pay at a GMSV dealership. With government statutory charges, the car could be expected to cost close to \$290,000 on road in Queensland, where it was sold.

There we have it. A C8 Corvette placed on the open market with eager bidders showing what they would pay to own one. This gives us a clear idea of what a C8 is currently considered to be worth in Australia.


