If you require a VASS Certificate (the vehicle has been modified or is an imported vehicle)

If you require a VASS Certificate (the vehicle has been modified or is an imported vehicle) you will find an engineer near you on the VicRoads website.

Fill in the forms, bring them and a Current Roadworthy Certificate (and VASS Certificate If applicable) with your car to one of the Club Scrutineers who will verify and sign the forms. You can submit them to Vicroads after you have a receipt of payment to Corvettes of Melbourne of the required fee:

Membership: Single - \$80 plus joining fee of \$20

Family - \$100 plus joining fee of \$20

<u>Club Permit Scheme Fee</u>: \$30.00 Administration Fee Per Annum, The First Year's Membership, Plus One Year's Membership Fee in Advance (to remain a Financial member during Overlap of CPS Registration).

3. If a member ceases to be financial during the term of the permit then your vehicle will not be included on the Club Permit Scheme register. If such a situation occurs the vehicle is considered un-registered, Vic Roads will be notified accordingly.
