

How to repair damaged/ worn vinyl or leather seats in your Corvette or Daily Driver. (C4 as an example)

A nice car can look awful if the interior has gone to God. Corvette seats in particular are expensive to replace. \$1,200 US and counting for nice leather seats. Then there is the shipping. Oh God, need that lotto win.

Let me tell you, you can have those old worn cracked seats in your car looking like new for a fraction of the price of replacements.

To start. Assess what you have. Are the seams coming apart? Is the leather torn or the piping cracked or broken? Depending on the damage, replacing piping or a worn section of leather / vinyl can cost anywhere between \$A200-\$500. A good upholsterer can remove a torn section, replace some piping, and resew. Also worn foam on the seat cushion or back rest can be replaced at time of repairing. Good to ensure repair leather or vinyl has the same grain consistency No need to worry about colour matching as you are going to paint the seats.

If you have a lot of damage, eg. Two or more sections need to be repaired and foam needs to be replaced, you need to start looking at maybe replacing the lot. Weigh up your options first, get a quote from an upholsterer if you are not sure. We have an excellent upholsterer in our Club, Colin Somerton and I am sure he can help with repairs or replacement.

So let us assume your seats are not split but the leather is showing signs of cracking, fading or wear. Then believe it or not you can restore your seats for less than \$150.00. Let's read that right. Less than \$A150.00, and they will look like new. First thing is to remove the cushions out of your Vette. Not too hard consult YouTube if you have issues. The seat cushion is easy as it has a retaining wire clip just under the front of the seat. Push it back and out it pops. Back rest cushions can be bit more difficult. There are 4 lugs in the plastic bucket, and cushion has 4 vertical wires that clip into the lugs. I got an old large flat head screwdriver and ground a V in the middle of the tip so it clicks onto the wire, push inward and it will release. Good idea is to take the whole seat out and service the tracks, also makes life easier when reinstalling. Re-Install back rest cushion first then re-install the seat back into the car.

Once the cushions are out you need to remove from the leather or vinyl all the grease, wax, Armoral (Silicone) and other gunk that may have accumulated over the years.

Wash with soapy water and a good grease remover. Then clean the seat using a silicone remover, methylated spirts can also be used, but then rinse of with warm water and let dry.


When dry and depending on the condition of the leather or vinyl sand down the surface with fine sandpaper, make. Do not have a heart attack but a small electric sander is just fine for the job. It is Important to clean in all the groves, and cracks as they are to be filled sanded and painted so they need to be clean, so wash and let dry.

Next, carefully fill in all the cracks (cannot really fix holes or torn leather). Here you need to buy Leather/ Vinyl filler online https://sofarehab.com.au/product/leather-crack-filler/

Allow Leather crack filler to dry for a day or so, sand the whole surface with fine sandpaper. Any missed sections no problems fill and sand again. Then clean the whole seat again with Grease and Wax remover or soapy water. The paint manufacturer recommends Dissol.to clean the seats before painting (Dissol can be purchased at the time you buy your paint as they also stock it).



Paint. This can be a bit of a long haul. You need to take one of your seats to the paint supplier he needs to colour match and he needs a sample. On a 1993 anniversary I cut a small piece from under the cushion and used that as a sample. To save a journey you may be able to cut a piece of and post it to them.

Paint is a special leather and vinyl paint. The paint supplier is https://www.viponds.com.au/ and they are in Tullamarine. They may have a stockist near you, so I suggest you give them a call first. They have been making leather paint for ever. I painted the seats and door trims on a 1964 Thunderbird back in 1996. Then 26 years later I recently used the same paint to paint the seats in the Corvette.

Once you have the paint and you are ready to paint this will come as a shock. Paint is applied with a good quality paint brush. Just paint it on. One or two coats. Missed a bit no trouble just touch up as needed. Avoid runs. I applied one coat to where I have filled cracks and sanded. Allowed to dry for an hour. Then paint again twice. 1 Litre. tin cost approximately \$65 you will have enough paint left to paint the seats again and again for the next 20 years if needed (Paint is water based and does not go hard in the tin).




