



My Other Car

Return to AMC Rambler Americans

I was born and bred in Parramatta NSW and my father always had an interest in Ramblers. His first one was a 1958 pink Ambassador, followed by a 1967 American RHD "Rogue" and finally a white seven seat 1970 Rebel Wagon with the 360 V8. The 1967 Rogue was my first car and I learned to drive in it.



Dad said the Rogue belonged to a US diplomat, it only had one headrest, the chauffeur didn't get one and so the driver seat had no provision for the headrest. I took over the running and maintenance of the Rogue, while still at school.

The photos were taken around 1975 on a road trip that a university mate and I did to Cairns and back during uni holidays. We borrowed a two-man tent and loaded up my surfboard. We stopped at nearly every pub and beach on the way.

Mechanical support and parts were supplied over the years by Pendlebury Engineering



who had an engineering workshop in Grose Street Parramatta.

The Rogue was sold to a local mechanic and the last I heard was that the drivetrain was replaced with a Holden 202 and Tri-matic.

A few years later I bought a white four door 1967 American that I kept till 1978.

My Other Car

Many years later, around 2010, I started to look around for my 1967 Rogue with no success. Tried various clubs and forums to no avail. There is a faint lead that some remnants of the car could be with Stephen Fripp in Sydney. So I started a search for a Rogue that I could restore as a nostalgic tribute to my first car.

Finally, in 2015, I found a white 1966 Rogue in North Dakota via the AMC Forum.



I have visions of painting it metallic blue to match the blue/blue Rogue I used to have. I even built a plastic model in those colours as inspiration.



It wasn't until 2021 that I started work on making the car roadworthy and after quite a few problems, I got the car registered on Club Plates in 2022. Along the way I joined the AMC Rambler Club and have been impressed with the support of members and Colin Main in particular. I've done quite a few drives now and I'm still sorting out minor teething problems.

As you all know, my other passion is Corvettes, my 1969 Stingray was my first and is still a labour of love.


