

After the morning interclub meet up, our club will move to the nearby Werribee - Bridge Hotel for lunch from 12.00.


We encourage as many members as possible to join us in not only supporting the Werribee District Collectable Car Club but also our own club members who have been asking for a run on the West side of Melbourne.


