Christmas in July - 21st Pig & Whistle Olinda confirmed as this year's venue. Club will subsidise financial members for the lunch and numbers must be confirmed 1 week prior. Tony advised that venues providing a Xmas in July event are limited and costs increasing.

Corvette National Convention – Parkes Alive in 2025 March 28th / 31st 2025. Entry forms are now online at NSW Corvettes Unlimited Web Site and hard copy in monthly magazine.

#### **General Business:**

Cost of monthly magazine discussion.

Tony raised the need for the club to consider the ongoing viability of a printed monthly magazine. Only 28 are now receiving a printed magazine at \$50 each year. Increasing costs has the club subsidising \$50++ per member receiving a hard copy. (Printing & postage approaching \$3,000 p.a.). The committee is recommending a cost increase to \$100 p.a. for those who wish to receive a hard copy & highlighted ongoing printing in future years is looking 'unlikely'.

Significant and passionate discussion amongst the meeting with key points raised for further consideration by the committee being...

- If cost increased to \$100, some members would no longer want the printed magazine further increasing the cost per unit well above \$100+ and further impacting ongoing viability.
- Some members strongly recommended the club should reduce or eliminate subsidising events such as Xmas in July/End of Year functions to ensure the long and continued history of a printed magazine remains.
- Some members recommended to partially reduce subsidisation of events (that not all members can participate in) and increase the subsidisation of the printed magazine with some increase to the \$50 fee.

The committee should reconvene discussion to resolve this matter and incorporate feedback from the members.

Vic Roads Permit Renewals.

Dan Butters raised a Vic Roads Permit concern that they are sometimes omitting to send out renewals. Advised members to 'Beware & Check'.




