

Kathy's Scone Recipe

2 Cups SR flour. 1/4 cup SR Caster Sugar. 1/2 cup cream. 1/2 cup lemonade.

Pinch of salt.

**Place Flour, sugar & salt in bowl, & look lovingly at the mix.

**Mix to form a soft dough.

**Turn out onto a lightly floured surface.

**Knead lovingly until just combined.

**Press with loving hands to a thickness of about 2cm.

**Cut to size with a cutter.

**Brush tops with milk.

**Bake 10 minutes until lightly browned.

**Serve with strawberry jam and whipped cream.


