




Friday we were up early cleaning our cars and attending the festival registration,




Point Nepean - 2024





A Christmas Recipe – Limoncello by Pasquali

Ingredients..

- 5 lemons, peel only
- 1 1/4 cup pure grain alcohol
- glass jar with seal
- 3 cups of water
- 1 1/4 cup sugar

Method...

Using a vegetable peeler, peel the skin off of each lemon in long strips, making sure to only peel the skin and not peel into the white pith of the lemon. Place the strips into the glass jar and add the alcohol. For alcohol I use everclear or you can use vodka. Mix together and seal shut. Store in a dark, cold place, like a basement, for at least 3 - 30 days. After 3 - 30 days, continue to the next step. Add the water into a pot and bring to a boil. Once boiling, add the sugar and heat over medium/low heat until the sugar has completely melted into the water. Remove from heat and set aside to cool off. Once the sugar water has cooled, strain the lemon alcohol into the sugar water and discard the peels. Mix together to make the limoncello. Transfer the limoncello into a bottle and store in the refrigerator. Serve the limoncello in chilled glasses and enjoy responsibly!




