

Jeep Restomod Accidentally Plows Into C2 Corvette, Trans Am, C7 ZR1 In Auction Parking Lot.

Multiple high-dollar collectible vehicles were damaged at a recent [Mecum Auctions](#) event in Fort Worth, Texas over the weekend after a driver apparently lost control of a 1958 Willys pickup restomod. The damaged vehicles include a 1977 [Pontiac](#) Firebird Trans Am, a 1966 C2 [Corvette](#), and a 2019 C7 [Corvette ZR1](#). The collision resulted in significant damage and reportedly sent three people to the hospital.



Photos from the event were posted to social media, showing the Willys pickup against the front passenger side fender of a C2 Corvette. The impact pushed the C2 in an adjacent black-and-gold Trans Am, which itself was shoved into a [C7 Corvette](#) ZR1.

Judging by the photos, it looks as though the Willys suffered moderate front-end damage, with the auction listing highlights like a 5.7L Hemi V8, an eight-speed automatic transmission, a custom extended cab, custom exterior work, and a custom cabin. The Willys failed to sell, although bidding did reach \$70,000 (presumably prior to the accident).

Jeep Restomod Accidentally Plows Into C2 Corvette, Trans Am, C7 ZR1 In Auction Parking Lot.



The C2 Corvette looks as though it was the biggest loser in the smashup, showing torn bodywork, a mangled hood, and bumper damage. The C2 is finished in rare Mosport Green (code 982) paint and is powered by the 327-cubic-inch L79 V8, paired with a four-speed manual transmission and showing 25,477 miles (41,200 km) on the clock, changing hands for \$126,500.

The 1977 Trans Am is also a low-mileage collector with just 23,070 miles (37,100 km), now showing some damage to the fender and a misaligned hood, with a listed selling price of \$64,020. Finally, the 2019 C7 Corvette ZR1 is practically brand new, with a mere 656 miles (1,060 km), tagged with a listed selling price of \$232,760.



The user that posted the photos to social media suggests that a driver associated with the auction may have accidentally had their foot slip while moving the Jeep, causing it to unintentionally surge forward and resulting in the four-way collector car pileup. According to a report from [Carscoops](#), Mecum has yet to confirm the circumstances surrounding the incident, while the condition of the individuals who were injured and details on who will pay for all the damage have yet to be announced as well.






