Lemonade Scones

2 cups SR Flour - sifted
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup Caster Sugar
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup cream
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup lemonade $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon salt

Place flour, sugar + salt in a large bowl. Add the cream + lemonade and mix to form a soft dough. Turn out onto a lightly floured workbench and knead lightly until combined. Press dough with your hands to a thickness of about 2cm. 6cm round cutter. Cut out 8 scones place on a baking tray + brush tops with some milk. Re-roll scraps to make a few extra scones. Bake 10-15 minutes until lightly browned.

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Top 10 Corvette Features Enthusiasts Love but Rarely Use

Joe Kucinski – July, 2026 These 10 clever Corvette features are worth having, even if they spend most of their lives waiting for the perfect moment.



1. Launch Control - Launch control is a cool feature that we all love. It is the easiest way to get consistent acceleration results. It is one of the first things many people try as soon as they get a get equipped with the technology. And then they never use it again. Let's face it, Launch Control is about as practical as a swimming pool in Siberia. The opportunity to use it just doesn't present itself very often. If you leave every stop sign and traffic light using Launch Control you are going to look like a tool and likely attract the attention of the police. You don't use it on a racetrack. You don't use it in the parking lot at Cars and Coffee. It is basically useless in the real world. Yet, we all love it.



2. Front Axle Lift System - For decades drivers have managed to drive sports cars without ripping off their front bumper. Take it slow, approach at an angle and you will clear most driveways and speed bumps without an issue. But then the Front Axle List came along and made life easy. And like everything else on this list, it is helpful to have. But oftentimes, after you use it a couple times, you realize that if you just slow down, you really don't need it. The newer Corvette systems will allow you to set the Front Axle Lift to activate based on GPS location, so you don't even need to press the button. Cool. But still not really necessary.



3. Performance Data Recorder (PDR) - The Corvette's Performance Data Recorder (PDR) is one of the coolest pieces of technology Chevrolet has ever offered. Using onboard cameras and telemetry, it records your drive while capturing data like speed, throttle position, braking, steering angle, and even lap times. It's an incredible tool for improving your driving skills or reliving an exciting run on your favourite road. The catch? Most owners simply don't use it very often. Unless you're a regular at track days or enjoy reviewing driving footage, the PDR tends to become one of those impressive features that's appreciated more for its capability than its everyday usefulness. Track rats might love it but everyone else will ignore it.

4. Stealth Mode - Stealth Mode lets Corvette owners tame the car's thunderous exhaust with the push of a button, making early morning departures or late-night arrivals much more neighbour-friendly. It's a clever feature that proves the Corvette can be civilized when it needs to be. But let's be honest, most enthusiasts didn't buy a Corvette to keep it quiet. And depending on the model you have, engaging the mode can be extra steps that you just aren't interested in taking. The rumble of the V8 is a huge part of the ownership experience, and many drivers leave the exhaust in Sport or Track mode almost all the time. Stealth Mode is nice to have, but for most owners, it's used only when absolutely necessary.



5. Z-Mode - Z-Mode is one of the Corvette's coolest party tricks. It allows owners to create a custom driving profile by mixing and matching settings for the engine, transmission, steering, suspension, exhaust, and brake feel, then recall them instantly with the "Z" button on the steering wheel. Most enthusiasts enjoy the flexibility, but many are confused about how to set the car up to suit their needs anyway. And if they do take the time to find the perfect setup, they rarely change it again.



6. Removable Roof Panels - One of the Corvette's signature features is its removable roof panel, giving coupe owners the best of both worlds, a secure hardtop and open-air driving when the weather cooperates. It's one of the reasons enthusiasts choose the coupe over the convertible. Yet many owners don't remove the roof nearly as often as they expected. Taking it off, finding a safe place to store it (or storing it in the trunk and taking all the trunk space), and reinstalling it later takes a little planning. So, plenty of Corvettes spend most of their lives with the roof in place. Even so, owners love knowing open-air driving is always an option.

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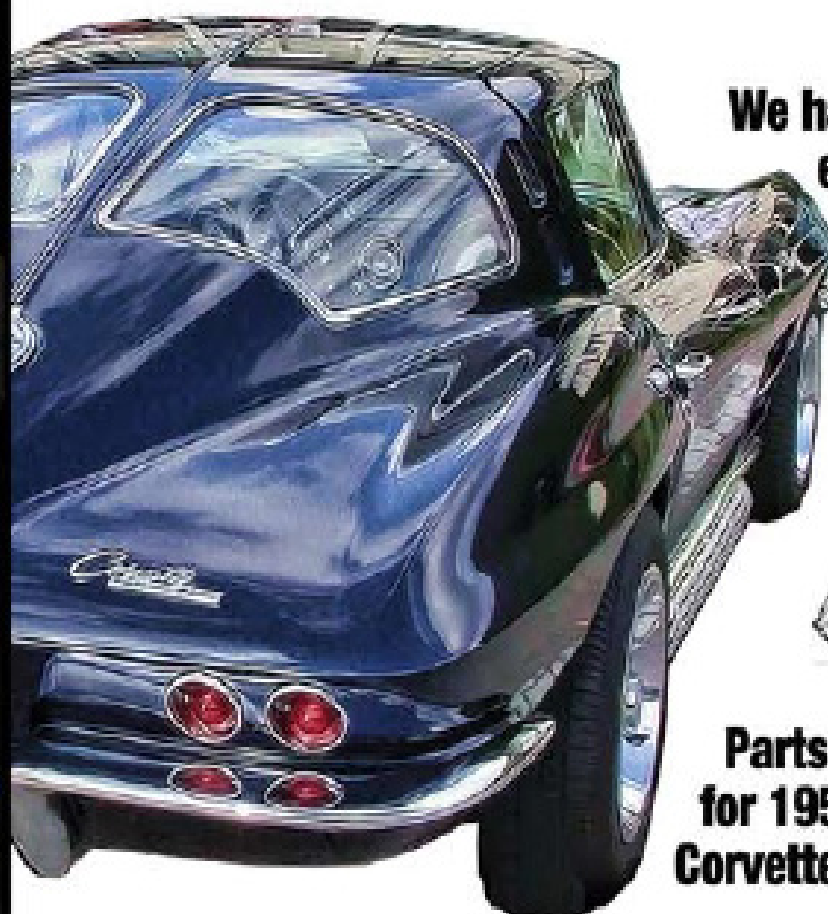
